



NOTICE OF PUBLIC LOGIC AND ACCURACY TEST for the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election

Posting Date: January 29, 2020

The Public Logic and Accuracy test for the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election will take place beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 4, 2020. The anticipated completion date is Thursday, February 6, 2020.

The test is open to representatives of the political parties, the press and the public in accordance with section 1-7-509(2) (b) C.R.S.

C.R.S. § 1-7-509(3) requires notice of the public test to be posted in the county for at least seven days before the test begins. Hours of the testing may vary.
