Military & Overseas Voters

We work to ensure that military and overseas voters are able to vote as efficiently as possible from far away locations. These voters are called "UOCAVA" voters, termed by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA). This special class of voters includes men and women serving in the armed forces, their dependents, and others whose circumstances take them out of the country.

- Ballots Sent Sept. 20, 2019
- UOCAVA Ballots mailed to 1567 voters, emailed to 2815 voters
 - 4,382 total sent
- Universal Postal Union
 - Universal Postal Union Extraordinary Congress voted in favor of a compromise proposal that allows the United States to set its own inbound postage rates. The U.S. has decided to remain in the Universal Postal Union.

- UOCAVA Ballots Sent
 - Friday, September 20, 2019
- Logic & Accuracy Test
 - First week in October
- Ballots Mailed
 - October 11, 2019 (Columbus Day Holiday)
- Voter Service and Polling Centers
 - Phase 1- October 14, 2019 (Citizens Service Center)
 - Phase 2- October 28, 2019 (4 Clerk branch locations)
 - Phase 3-November 4, 2019 (Town of Monument and Victory World Outreach)
- Risk Limiting Audit
 - November 15, 2019, last day for SOS to notify counties of the ballots selected for audit (by 11:59 pm)
- Four Elections in 12 month span

2020 Elections

- Presidential Primary-March 3, 2020
- Primary – June 30, 2020
- Presidential General Election- November 3, 2020
